



Ivanhoe Girls' Grammar School Facilities

Ivanhoe Girls' Grammar School is situated about 10kms from the centre of Melbourne in the residential suburb of Ivanhoe. It is an established suburb and with excellent transport links to the city and adjoining suburbs. The School is located close to Ivanhoe Shopping Centre.

The School, which was established in 1903, is a mix of older Edwardian houses and new state-of-the-art modern buildings.

Whole School Facilities

- Performing Arts Centre with a 500 seat auditorium
- Lecture Theatre
- Hillsley – the Visual Art and Hospitality Centre
- Gymnasium
- Indoor heated 25m pool
- Sports field – all weather, synthetic surface (includes five netball courts)
- Library – Senior and Junior areas
 - – approximately 25,000 titles: e.g. periodicals, major newspapers)
 - – technology resources – about 90 laptop computers for student use
 - – audiovisual centre
- Café.

Senior School

- Year level centres for each level from Years 7 to 12
- Approximately 50 classrooms including six Science laboratories. All classrooms are networked and have interactive whiteboards
- Student Services Centre for first aid and welfare matters
- Music centre with a computer room with keyboards, rehearsal rooms and individual practice rooms.

Primary School

- Twelve classrooms – all networked and have interactive whiteboards
- Specialist Art and Music rooms.
